1 INSTALLATION & COMPATIBILITY

The release of Hotfix 1 introduces several improvements and ensures compatibility for Advance Steel users. This hotfix can be installed over existing versions (2024.0) and includes an update to the PowerPack for Advance Steel. Notably, it maintains compatibility with other 2024.0.1 Graitec releases.

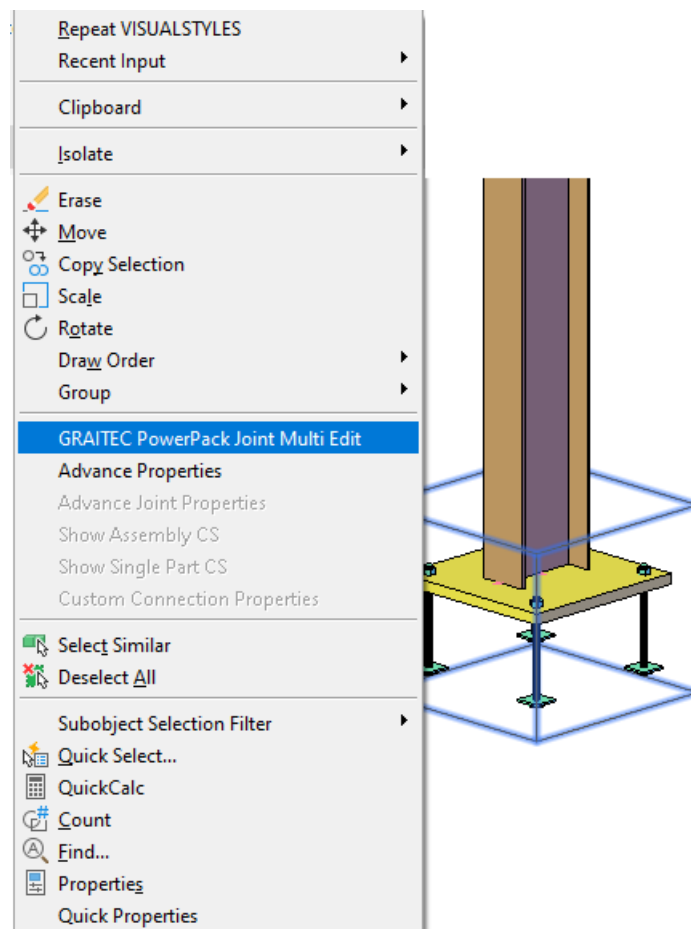
2 IMPROVEMENTS AND CORRECTIONS

Included below are the specific details regarding the improvements and corrections introduced in this hotfix release:

2.1 GRAITEC JOINT MULTI-EDIT, FUNCTIONALITY RESTORED

One of the features offered by the PowerPack for Advance Steel is the contextual menu option for multiple joint editing, for both Advance Steel and PowerPack joints. However, it was noted that in the 2024 version of Advance Steel, in certain scenarios, the functionality failed to interpret joint information accurately and to apply the required updates.

This behavior has been corrected with Hotfix 1, thereby restoring the full operation of the joint multi-edit command.

2.2 TOWER DESIGNERS: INCLUDED IN THE AUSTRALIAN BUILD

The Tower Designers module is now available for the Australian installation of the Powerpack for Advance Steel. This addition allows users in Australia to benefit from the same extensive functionality that is available in other country distributions.
